■ Webside Chat with Montana State Librarian, Jennie Stapp, on Friday, March 12, 2021 @ Noon Zoom meetings (recorded for MSL Vimeo channel) usually held on the 2nd Friday of each month

Some of the topics addressed included:

- Montana Legislative Session @ www.leg.mt.gov
 - Bills discussed:
 - o HB 2: General Appropriations Act
 - HB 501: Generally revise criminal procedure and criminal laws
 - o HB 374: Amend Coal Severance Tax SSR accounts, provide transfers
 - HB 632: Implement receipt of an appropriate federal stimulus and COVID recovery funds
- American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) Funding = approximately \$2 million
 - Funding areas include:
 - MSL Hot Spot Program continuance
 - Additional Library eResources (MTLibrary2Go, etc.)
 - The State Library Commission will take preliminary actions at the April meeting; more discussions in May/June
- eRate Funding = approximately \$7 billion [usually \$2 billion in a normal year]
 - Patron services that could be funded include:
 - Hot spots/tablets/laptops/computers and other equipment
 - Wi-fi extension beyond a library building
- Excellent Library Service Award (ELSA) Update
 - Changes include: a survey-like application, explanation areas, and more interactive
- Montana Library Network "Reboot" & Network Advisory Council (NAC)
 - New NAC at the beginning of the fiscal year; they will prioritize funding for the services within the network
 - Core Services Committee currently working on answering funding needs, job descriptions, future vision, etc.
