CONRAD PUBLIC LIBRARY POLICY: PROGRAMS

The Conrad Public Library provides programming options designed to appeal to community interests and promote various resources, services, and educational opportunities. Programs may be held at the Library building or at a different location. Registration may be required for planning purposes or when space is limited; registration (complete with a parent's signature) is required for many of the children's programs.

Programs shall be presented by one (1) or more of our librarians, or the Library may participate with other community agencies, organizations, education and cultural institutions, business leaders, and/or individuals to develop and present programs. Professional performers and presenters may also be hired. A program's content, products, services, materials, and the views expressed by the presenter(s) and/or participant(s) does not constitute the Library's endorsement, nor does the Library assume any legal liability or responsibility of the program's accuracy or completeness.

Programming is offered free of charge to patrons, unless designed as a fundraising event by the Conrad Public Library Foundation or by the Friends of the Conrad Public Library.

The Conrad Public Library reserves the right to use photographs taken during programs for use in promoting the Library within publications, marketing materials (such as the website), and social media; a child's photo can be used unless otherwise noted on the registration form.
